Prospective Three-Wheeled Motorcycle Driver

If you are a new driver of a three-wheeled motorcycle, to operate this type of vehicle in Québec you must:

 hold a valid Class 6A driver's licence or probationary licence (all types of motorcycles);

or

 hold a valid Class 6A learner's licence (all types of motorcycles) and operate your vehicle in the presence of an accompanying driver;

or

hold a valid Class 5 driver's licence (passenger vehicle)
and successfully complete the Road Safety Education
Program – Operating a Three-Wheeled Motorcycle
driving course.

One-Day Course

The Road Safety Education Program – Operating a Three-Wheeled Motorcycle driving course lasts 7 hours. The goals of the program are:

- to promote safe, cooperative and responsible driving;
- · to prepare to operate a three-wheeled motorcycle;
- to educate about the related risks on the road network.

The course is offered by motorcycle driving schools recognized by the Association québécoise du transport et des routes (AQTR).
