AIRPORTS WITH NAV CANADA AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWERS

- In June 2002, the number of landings and take-offs at the 43 Canadian airports with control towers totalled 437,874. This represents a decrease of 27,810 movements or 6.0% when compared to the 465,684 movements reported in June 2001. Itinerant movements decreased by 5.6% or 17,308 movements as well as the local class by 10,502 movements or 6.7%.
- Toronto/LB Pearson Intl was the most active airport in both the overall and itinerant classes of operation with 32,857 movements respectively. The local category was led by Boundary Bay with 11,300 movements.

AÉROPORTS AVEC TOUR DE CONTRÔLE DE LA CIRCULATION AÉRIENNE DE NAV CANADA

- Le nombre total de décollages et d'atterrissages aux 43 aéroports canadiens dotés de tour de contrôle s'est chiffré à 437 874 en juin 2002. Cela représente une diminution de 27 810 mouvements ou 6,0 % comparativement aux 465 684 mouvements rapportés en juin 2001. La classe itinérante a diminué de 5,6 % ou 17 308 mouvements de même que la classe locale de 10 502 mouvements ou 6,7 %.
- L'aéroport de Toronto/LB Pearson Intl a été le plus affairé quant au trafic global de même que pour la classe itinérante avec 32 857 mouvements respectivement. L'aéroport de Boundary Bay a dominé la classe locale avec 11 300 mouvements.

**AIRPORTS WITH NAV CANADA
FLIGHT SERVICE STATIONS**

- In June 2002, total air traffic activity at the 56 airports with NAV CANADA Flight Service Stations totalled 120,540 movements. This represents a decrease of 7,821 movements when compared to the 128,361 movements reported for 55 airports in June 2001. The itinerant category decreased by 555 movements or 0.6% as well as the local category by 7,266 movements or 23.4%.
- Fort McMurray was the most active airport in both the overall and itinerant classes of operation with 5,550 and 5,102 movements respectively. The local category was led by Kingston with 2,690 movements.

**AÉROPORTS AVEC STATIONS D'INFORMATION DE VOL
DE NAV CANADA**

- En juin 2002, le trafic aérien aux 56 aéroports avec stations d'information de vol de NAV CANADA s'est chiffré à 120 540 mouvements. Ceci représente une diminution de 7 821 mouvements comparativement aux 128 361 mouvements rapportés aux 55 aéroports en juin 2001. La classe itinérante a diminué de 555 mouvements ou 0,6 % de même que la classe locale de 7 266 mouvements ou 23,4 %.
- L'aéroport de Fort McMurray a été le plus affairé quant au trafic global de même que pour la classe itinérante avec 5 550 et 5 102 mouvements respectivement. L'aéroport de Kingston a dominé la classe locale avec 2 690 mouvements.

INTRODUCTION

Survey Universe

Coverage

Airports with Air Traffic Control Towers: the statistics appearing in the section cover itinerant and local movements reported by the air traffic control units at the 43 NAV CANADA control towers.

Airports with Flight Service Stations: the statistics appearing in the section are for itinerant and local movements reported by the 56 NAV CANADA Flight Service Stations.

Methodology

The itinerant Movement Record is designed to capture:

- Aircraft Identification
- Aircraft Type
- The last station before landing at the reporting airport or the next station after take-off
- Arrival or Departure
- Time of Movement
- Runway Used
- Flight Rules (Instrument Flight Rules or Visual Flight Rules).

The Local Aircraft Movement Record provides for reports of local movements by:

- Hour
- Single Engine Aircraft
- Multi-Engine Aircraft
- Jet Aircraft
- Military Aircraft
- Date of Movement

Processing of aircraft movement statistics involves several stages. Preliminary monthly data by class of operation are released in a single sheet bulletin, Preliminary Aircraft Movement Statistics - TP-1496 (NAV CANADA towered airports only). Data which follow in Aircraft Movement Statistics - Monthly Report - TP-141 may contain revisions to the originally released figures. Annual tables, which may reflect further revisions, are released in the publication, Aircraft Movement Statistics - Annual Report - TP-577. In particular, data on itinerant movements by type of operation may reflect revisions as various sources of comparative information (data collected from commercial air carriers by the Aviation Statistics Centre, Statistics Canada) become available during the processing cycle. Finally, when revisions are required after the release of TP-577, they are contained in the five year historical summary of subsequent editions of TP-577.

The records are completed daily, based on a twenty-four hour clock running from zero hour to 23:59. The times recorded are Coordinated Universal Time (UTC); however, published statistics are shown in local times. The records are transmitted to the Aviation Statistics Centre.

The Aviation Statistics Centre maintains a data base of parameter files of current information on all registered aircraft. The storage of this information reduces the reporting burden of the survey respondents and limits the element of human error associated with the preparation of source documents.

INTRODUCTION

Univers de l'enquête

Champ de l'enquête

Aéroports avec tour de contrôle de la circulation aérienne: les statistiques présentées à la section donnent les mouvements itinérants et locaux enregistrés par les unités de contrôle de la circulation aérienne aux 43 tours de contrôle de NAV CANADA.

Aéroports avec station d'information de vol: les statistiques présentées à la section sont pour les mouvements itinérants et locaux enregistrés par les 56 stations d'information de vol de NAV CANADA.

Méthodologie de l'enquête

Le Rapport sur les mouvements itinérants d'aéronefs a pour objet de capter les renseignements suivants:

- L'identification de l'aéronef
- Le type ou genre d'aéronef
- L'origine du dernier rapport précédent l'atterrissement à l'aéroport déclarant ou la destination du vol après le décollage
- L'arrivée ou le départ
- L'heure précise du mouvement
- La piste utilisée
- Les règles de vol (vols visuels ou aux instruments).

Le Rapport sur les mouvements locaux d'aéronefs sert à répartir les mouvements locaux selon:

- L'heure
- Monomoteurs
- Multimoteurs
- Avions à réaction
- Avions militaires
- Date du mouvement

Plusieurs étapes sont utilisées dans le processus de la statistique relative aux mouvements des aéronefs. Des résultats provisoires sont fournis dans un bulletin d'une simple feuille - Résultats provisoires, statistiques relatives aux mouvements d'aéronefs - TP-1496 (Aéroports avec tour de contrôle de NAV CANADA). Les données qui suivent dans le rapport Statistiques relatives aux mouvements d'aéronefs, Rapport mensuel - TP-141 peuvent contenir des révisions, c'est-à-dire des chiffres provenant d'une compilation plus complète et détaillée. Des tableaux annuels sont distribués dans le rapport intitulé Statistiques relatives aux mouvements d'aéronefs, Rapport annuel - TP-577. Il est à noter dans ce rapport que les types d'opérations des mouvements itinérants peuvent refléter d'autres révisions provenant de différentes sources d'information comparative, (données reçues des transporteurs pour le Centre des Statistiques de l'aviation, Statistique Canada) au fur et à mesure que ces informations nous parviennent, les fichiers sont révisés et reflètent les changements. Finalement, lorsque des révisions sont requises après la distribution du rapport TP-577, celles-ci sont contenues dans le sommaire des chiffres historiques des cinq dernières années dans les éditions suivantes de ce rapport.

Les rapports sont complétés quotidiennement et fondés sur une période d'une journée de 24 heures allant de 0 à 23:59 heures. Les temps enregistrés sont d'après le Temps universel coordonné (UTC); toutefois, les statistiques publiées sont montrées en temps locaux. Les déclarations sont transmises tous les jours au Centre des statistiques de l'aviation.

Le Centre des statistiques de l'aviation maintient une base de données avec un fichier des paramètres sur toutes les marques d'immatriculation des aéronefs. L'emmagasinage de ces renseignements permet d'alléger le fardeau des répondants appelés à fournir les données et de plus contribue à minimiser les erreurs inhérentes à la préparation des documents de référence.

Other parameter files information includes registered aircraft identifications and their corresponding aircraft types, gross take-off weights, types of power plant (piston, jet or turboprop); whether the aircraft are fixed wing, helicopters or gliders. This information also provides a basis for identifying type of flights (commercial, private and government) and the geographical area in which the flights take place.

The parameter files also include Airport Environment information against which the airport category is checked; the reported runway is validated and the time difference between UTC and Local is assigned.

Data Quality and Limitations

Aircraft Movement Statistics are accumulated from data originating with air traffic control tower units or Flight Services Stations personnel. Because staff in these positions are highly trained in factual observation and reporting, the entries in the data bank are of a high quality.

The procedures for reporting aircraft movements on the Daily Air Traffic Records by tower units are described in the NAV CANADA Air Traffic Control Manual of Operations (TP 703) Volume 1, Para. 1121 to 1122.9. Definitions for terms used in these paragraphs can be found in Volume 1, Part 1 General Para. 107 of the Manual. These are also shown in the Glossary of Terms in back of this report. Procedures for reporting aircraft movements by Flight Service Station personnel are described in the Flight Service Station manual of Operations (TP 2043E), Volume 2, Chapter 22, Para. 3.2 to 3.24.

To maintain uniformity in the reporting of source data, ASC issues to air traffic control units an "Air Traffic Designators" handbook (TP 143) listing the official Transport Canada aircraft type designators and the designators of various domestic and international air carriers. This handbook and another titled "Canada Flight Supplement" listing various airport codes serve as references to help ensure the reporting of the proper aircraft identity and the point of origin and destination of flights.

The processing system contains editing procedures designed to identify data errors occurring during transcription or during data capture of forms. Identified errors are manually corrected by ASC editing staff.

Errors may occur if an aircraft type code which exists is reported or data captured in error for a flight. For example, the reporting or keying of B727 for a flight actually performed by a B737 may not be detected during the system editing. That the aircraft type information is recorded by highly trained air traffic control tower staff using a common handbook of official aircraft codes will minimize this problem.

Similarly, the breakdown of the data on a geographic basis by use of location codes can be subject to error. For smaller locations, alphanumeric location codes are often used and the sequence of numbers and letters determines the geographic area to which the data are assigned. In some cases, where a sequence error has been introduced into the system either at the reporting unit or at data capture, a domestic movement may be classified as transborder or vice versa. The use of common manuals of location identifiers works to minimize this occurrence.

Autres informations du fichier des paramètres fournissent des renseignements comme les marques d'immatriculation d'aéronefs assorties avec les genres correspondants d'avions, le poids brut au décollage des appareils, le type du groupe motopropulseur (à piston, à réaction ou turbo) et détermine si l'aéronef est à voilure fixe ou tournante ou si c'est un planeur. Cette information sert également à identifier le genre de vols effectués par des appareils commerciaux, privés ou gouvernementaux et la région géographique des vols.

Le fichier des paramètres renferme en outre l'information sur l'environnement de l'aéroport qui permet de vérifier sa catégorie. La piste déclarée est homologuée et la différence entre l'UTC et l'heure locale est assignée.

Normes de qualité et restrictions des données

Les statistiques relatives aux mouvements d'aéronefs sont accumulées à partir des données provenant des unités des tours de contrôle de la circulation aérienne ou du personnel des stations d'information de vol. Étant donné que le personnel de ces positions est hautement formé et possède une expertise dans la surveillance des opérations et la manière de remplir les déclarations, il s'ensuit donc que les statistiques qui entrent dans la banque des données sont de haute qualité.

Les méthodes pour rapporter les mouvements d'aéronefs sur les Rapports quotidiens de la circulation aérienne par les unités des tours de contrôle sont décrites dans le Manuel des opérations du contrôle de la circulation aérienne de NAV CANADA (TP 703) Volume 1, paragraphes 1121 à 1122.9. La définition des termes utilisés dans ces paragraphes apparaît au Volume 1, Partie 1 Générale, paragraphe 107 du manuel. Les définitions sont également publiées dans le Lexique à la fin du rapport. Les instructions pour rapporter les mouvements des aéronefs par le personnel des stations d'information de vol sont décrites dans le Manuel d'opérations des stations d'information de vol (TP 2043F), Volume 2, Chapitre 22, Para. 3.2 à 3.24.

Afin de conserver un certain élément d'uniformité dans les données de référence, le Centre des statistiques de l'aviation met à l'usage des unités de contrôle le manuel intitulé "Indicateurs de la circulation aérienne" (TP 143). Cette publication renferme les indicateurs officiels de Transports Canada pour chaque type d'aéronef de même que les indicateurs de plusieurs transporteurs aériens assurant des services intérieurs et internationaux. Ce dernier manuel et celui intitulé "Canada supplément de vol" qui identifie les codes des différents aéroports servent de documents de référence pour aider à l'identification adéquate des aéronefs et l'origine et destination des vols.

Les cycles de vérification font partie des programmes du traitement des données sur l'ordinateur et sert à identifier les erreurs commises lors de l'échange des données ou capté par formulaire. Les erreurs identifiées sont corrigées manuellement par les préposés à la vérification au Centre des statistiques de l'aviation.

Des erreurs peuvent survenir si le type d'aéronef est rapporté ou capté en erreur pour une envolée. Par exemple, le rapport ou le captage d'un B727 pour une envolée au lieu d'un B737, la vérification du système pourrait ne pas détecter cette erreur. L'information du type d'aéronef est rapporté par des contrôleurs très spécialisés dans la circulation aérienne, utilisant des codes officiels d'un manuel commun qui minimiserait ce problème.

Les données sont séparées par endroit géographique en utilisant des codes d'identification, ceux-ci pourraient donner lieu à des erreurs. Pour les petites localités des codes composés lettres-chiffres sont souvent utilisés et ceux-ci déterminent les emplacements géographiques auxquels les données sont assujettis. Dans certains cas, quand une séquence est introduite en erreur dans le système soit par l'unité rapportant ou durant le captage, un mouvement intérieur pourrait être classifié comme transfrontalier ou vice versa. L'utilisation des manuels pour des codes d'identification d'emplacements aide à minimiser cette anomalie.

Factors influencing the data

The Churchill airport underwent a category change in March 2002. It was changed from a Small airport (Volume 2) to a Flight Service Station (Volume 1).

Facteurs influents sur les données

L'aéroport de Churchill a changé de catégorie de tour en mars 2002. Il est passé des petits aéroports (Volume 2) aux stations d'information de vol (Volume 1).

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

AIR CARRIER - Aircraft Operators, Licensed by the Canadian Transportation Agency to transport persons, mail and/or goods by air.

Level I-III air carriers consist of Canadian air carriers which, in each of the two years preceding the reporting year, carried five thousand or more revenue passengers, one thousand or more tonnes of revenue goods or both. Also include foreign air carriers.

Canadian air carriers not meeting the definition for Levels I-III have been assigned to Levels IV-VI.

AIRCRAFT MOVEMENT - A take off, a landing, or a simulated approach by an aircraft. ATC MANOPS Amendment 8-8-83. NC-703.

CLASS OF OPERATION- Aircraft movements are classified as either "Itinerant" or "Local".

COMMERCIAL- Flights by aircraft operators licensed by the Canadian Transportation Agency to perform commercial air services. Commercial operations are divided into two categories: AIR CARRIER and OTHER COMMERCIAL.

DOMESTIC ITINERANT MOVEMENTS- Movements, at a Canadian airport, of aircraft departing to or arriving from another point in Canada.

FSS- Flight Service Station.

GOVERNMENT-CIVIL- Aircraft owned by federal, provincial and municipal bodies as well as foreign states, but excluding those owned by crown corporations, boards and commissions. Such aircraft are coded "3" under "Purpose" in the Canadian Civil Aircraft Register.

GOVERNMENT-MILITARY- Aircraft of any branch of the armed forces of any nation.

GROSS TAKE-OFF WEIGHT- The maximum weight for which the aircraft is licensed to operate. For operational purposes, all weights are rounded upwards to the next 1 000 kilograms. Thus 3 200 kilograms becomes 4 000 kilograms.

I.F.R. FLIGHT- A flight conducted in accordance with Instrument Flight Rules.

INTERNATIONAL MOVEMENTS- Movements, at a Canadian airport, of aircraft arriving from or departing to a point outside Canada. International movements are subclassified into "transborder" (to or from a point in the United States including Alaska but excluding Hawaii), and "other international" (to or from points in countries other than Canada and the United States).

Since aircraft movements are reported on the basis of place "arrived from" or "departed to", an arrival at Mirabel airport from London, England would appear under "other international". If the same aircraft moved on to Toronto, both the departure at Mirabel and the arrival at Toronto would be shown as "domestic".

ITINERANT MOVEMENTS- At Airports With Control Towers and/or Flight Service Stations: for the purpose of completing air traffic records, itinerant movements are considered as movements in which aircraft proceed to or arrive from another location; or where aircraft leave the circuit but return without landing at another airport. At Airports Without Control Towers: an aircraft movement in which the aircraft arrives from or departs to a point other than the reporting airport; or a movement by an aircraft that leaves the close proximity of an airport and returns without landing at another airport.

LOCAL MOVEMENTS- At Airports With Control Towers and/or Flight Service Stations: for the purpose of completing air traffic records, local movements are considered as movements in which the aircraft remains in the circuit. At Airports Without Control Towers: an aircraft movement in which the aircraft remains in the close proximity of the airport. Local movements are often carried out during training flights (touch-and-go), equipment tests etc.

OTHER COMMERCIAL- Flights performed by COMMERCIAL aircraft operators not included in the AIR CARRIER categories.
Flying schools, agricultural sprayers, water-bombers, aerial photography and survey, etc.

POWER PLANT- The source of propulsion. For example, piston engines, turbo-propellers and jet engines. "Helicopters", in this report, include both piston and turboshaft-driven engines.

PRIVATE AIRCRAFT- Aircraft used solely for private purposes, not for hire and compensation, which are classified as "Private" or "Private Restricted" in the Canadian Civil Aircraft Register or similar registries of other countries. Owners include individuals, groups and business firms.

RUNWAY 88- Through control zone flights, i.e. flights which communicate with the tower while transiting the tower control zone to another destination without landing at the reporting airport.

Data for these runways are not included in the grand total.

SIMULATED APPROACHES- Movements that are either missed instrument or practice instrument approaches without landing.

TC - Transport Canada.

TOWER CONTROL ZONE- A controlled airspace within the proximity of an air traffic control tower, usually within a radius of less than 24 kilometres of the tower.

V.F.R. FLIGHT- A flight conducted in accordance with Visual Flight Rules.

WEIGHT GROUP- The classification of weight classes in groups for statistical purposes.

LEXIQUE

AÉRONEF PRIVÉ- Aéronef destiné exclusivement à l'usage privé et non à un but lucratif ou rémunérateur, et classé comme étant "privé" ou "privé restreint" dans le Registre d'immatriculation des aéronefs civils canadiens ou les registres semblables à d'autres pays. Les propriétaires comprennent les particuliers, les associations ou les entreprises.

APPROCHE SIMULÉE- Approche manquée aux instruments ou exercice d'approche aux instruments sans atterrissage.

AUTRES VOLS COMMERCIAUX- Tous les vols effectués par les exploitants d'aéronefs qui assurent des services commerciaux et qui ne sont pas compris dans les catégories TRANSPORTEURS AÉRIENS.

Écoles de pilotage, pulvérisateurs à usage agricole, bombardiers d'eau, photographie aérienne technique.

CLASSE DE VOL- Les mouvements d'aéronefs sont répartis en mouvements "itinérants" ou "locaux".

FSS- Stations d'information de vol.

GROUPE DE POIDS- Classification des classes de poids en groupes aux fins de la statistique.

GROUPE MOTOPROPULSEUR- La source de propulsion, soit par exemple, les moteurs à pistons, les turbopropulseurs et les moteurs à réaction. Dans cette publication, les hélicoptères comprennent les moteurs à pistons ainsi que les moteurs à turbine à arbre.

MOUVEMENT D'AÉRONEF- Tout décollage, atterrissage ou toute approche simulée par un aéronef. Le Manops Modificatif 8-8-83. NC-703.

MOUVEMENT ITINÉRANT INTÉRIEUR- Mouvement à un aéroport canadien d'aéronefs à destination ou en provenance d'un autre endroit situé au Canada.

MOUVEMENTS INTERNATIONAUX- Mouvements à un aéroport canadien d'aéronefs à destination ou en provenance de l'étranger. Les mouvements internationaux se subdivisent en "transfrontaliers" (à destination ou en provenance d'un endroit aux États-Unis, y compris l'Alaska mais sans Hawaii) et "autres mouvements internationaux" (à destination ou en provenance de pays autres que le Canada et les États-Unis).

Puisque les mouvements d'aéronefs sont déclarés en fonction de la "provenance" ou de la "destination", une arrivée à l'aéroport de Mirabel en provenance de Londres, Angleterre paraîtra sous le titre "Autres mouvements internationaux". Si le même aéronef se rend ensuite à Toronto, le départ de Mirabel et l'arrivée à Toronto sont comptés comme "mouvements intérieurs".

MOUVEMENTS ITINÉRANTS- Aux aéroports avec tour de contrôle et aux stations de services de vols: aux fins de la rédaction des registres de circulation aérienne, sont considérés comme mouvements itinérants: les mouvements dans lesquels les aéronefs partent à destination ou arrivent en provenance d'une autre lieu; ou les mouvements où les aéronefs quittent le circuit mais reviennent pour atterrir. Aux aéroports sans tour de contrôle: une arrivée ou un départ d'aéronef en provenance ou à destination d'un lieu autre que l'aéroport déclarant. Il s'applique également à un mouvement où l'aéronef quitte les environs de l'aéroport déclarant et y retourne sans atterrir à un autre aéroport.

MOUVEMENTS LOCAUX- Aux aéroports avec tour de contrôle et aux stations de services de vols: aux fins de la rédaction des registres de circulation aérienne, sont considérés comme mouvements locaux, les mouvements dans lesquels les aéronefs restent dans le circuit. Aux aéroports sans tour de contrôle: un mouvement effectué par des aéronefs qui opèrent dans les environs de l'aéroport déclarant. Les mouvements locaux sont souvent effectués lors des vols d'entraînement (posé-décollé), lors des essais de l'équipement, etc.

OFFICIEL-CIVIL- Comprend les aéronefs appartenant à l'administration publique fédérale, provinciale ou municipale ainsi qu'aux gouvernements étrangers mais non ceux qui appartiennent à des sociétés de la Couronne ou à des commissions. Ces aéronefs sont codés "3" sous utilisation dans le Registre d'immatriculation des aéronefs civils canadiens.

OFFICIEL MILITAIRE- Aéronef d'un service des forces armées de n'importe quel pays.

PISTE 88- Vol où l'aéronef traverse la zone de contrôle, c'est-à-dire où l'appareil entre en communication avec l'aéroport alors qu'il traverse la zone de contrôle de la tour et se dirige vers une autre destination sans atterrissage à l'aéroport déclarant. Ces données ne sont pas comprises dans le total des mouvements.

POIDS BRUT AU DÉCOLLAGE- Le poids maximum où un aéronef est autorisé à exploiter des services en vertu d'un permis. Pour les fins de l'enquête, tous les poids sont arrondis au millier supérieur. Ainsi 3 200 kilogrammes entrera dans la classe des 4 000 kilogrammes.

TC- Le Ministère des transports du Canada (Tranports Canada).

TRANSPORT AÉRIEN - Les exploitants d'aéronefs titulaires d'un permis de l'Office des transports du Canada assurant par air le transport de passagers, marchandises et/ou courriers.

Des transporteurs aériens des niveaux I-III comprennent des transporteurs aériens Canadiens qui, au cours de chacune des deux années précédent immédiatement l'année de déclaration, a transporté au moins cinq milles passagers payants, au moins mille tonne de marchandises payantes, ou les deux. Incluant aussi les transporteurs aériens étrangers.

Autres transporteurs aériens canadiens qui ne sont pas dans niveaux I-III sont assignés aux niveaux IV-VI.

VOLS COMMERCIAUX- Vols effectués par des exploitants d'aéronefs, titulaires d'un permis de l'Office des transports du Canada pour assurer des transports pour assurer des services aériens commerciaux. Pour la liste de ces transporteurs, se reporter à la Partie I du Répertoire des services aériens commerciaux du Canada. L'exploitation commerciale est répartie en deux catégories, notamment, les TRANSPORTEURS AÉRIENS et les AUTRES VOLS COMMERCIAUX.

VOL I.F.R.- Vol effectué selon les règles de vol aux instruments.

VOL V.F.R.- Vol effectué selon les règles de vol visuel.

ZONE CONTRÔLÉE DE LA TOUR DE CONTRÔLE- Un espace aérien contrôlé à proximité de la tour de contrôle de la circulation aérienne, habituellement situé dans un rayon de moins de 24 kilomètres de la tour.
